

Quilt Registration Information

Information about: Quilt Sizes, Categories and Descriptions of Techniques

Bed Size Quilts are intended for use on a bed or sofa.

Large quilts (L) have a perimeter of 300" or more.

Small quilts (S) have a perimeter of 299" or less.

The technique, quilting method and number of makers must be indicated on the entry form.

Wall Quilts are intended for display on wall. Must have hanging sleeve or other means of hanging included. Please indicate whether hand or machine quilted.

Miniature -- 24"x 24" Maximum

1 Person Quilt -- All work must be completed by one person, the person entering the quilt for competition.

2 Person Quilt -- The entry is a product of 2 people; i.e. one person constructs the quilt and other quilts it.

Group Entry -- 3 or more makers

Junior Entry -- age 6-17

Pieced -- piecing predominates over other techniques in amount or effect.

Appliqué -- appliqué predominates over other techniques in amount or effect.

Mixed -- a quilt where two or more major construction techniques are used to develop the design of the top.

Other -- another type of quilt such as: painted, printed, crazy quilt, cathedral window, embroidered, pictorial, embellished, thread painted, whole cloth, etc.

Art quilt must be completely original work of the entrant.

Anyone or group can enter a cloth quilt (2 layers of fabric fixed with cross lines of stitching; a layer of padding may be included) by submitting a completed registration form and \$2.00 entry fee for each quilt. Quilts must be constructed by the person or group named on the entry form. Any information known about a family heirloom or antique quilt should accompany it.

Quilt sizes, categories, and descriptions are listed on the other side of this form. Persons will choose the category they wish their item to be judged. Persons may enter one item per category/size to be judged. Other items may be entered for display. If there is a question as to the category in which an item is to be entered Quilt Show Committee chairman and Quilt Registrar reserve the right to place the item in an appropriate category. This will be done at the time of registration.

Any item to be shown should be free of stains, discolorations, or soiling. **The Redbud Quilt Guild reserves the right to refuse quilts.**

Reasonable care will be taken to protect items submitted from accidents, loss, damage, and theft during the course of the event. Redbud Quilt Guild and its members is not in any way to be held responsible for accidents, loss, or damage by water, fire, theft, or otherwise whatever may be the cause or extent of the damage or loss. The quilter agrees to this prospectus.
