

2019 Quilt Show Registration Information

Anyone or group may enter a quilt/cloth item (2 layers of fabric fixed with stitching through all layers (a layer of batting may be included) by submitting a completed registration form and a \$2.00 entry fee for each item. Item is to have been constructed by the person(s) named as the quilt maker on the entry form. Items to be judged must have been completed after April, 2018. Any information of interest (inspiration for design/construction) should accompany the entry.

Descriptions of entry categories, sizes and construction techniques are listed on the other side of this form. Persons will choose the category in which they wish their item to be judged. Persons may enter only item per category/size to be judged. Other items may be entered for display only. If there is a question as to the category in which an item is to be entered the Quilt Show Committee Chairman and Quilt Registrar reserve the right to place an item in an appropriate category. This will be done at the time of registration. Ribbons for judged items will be awarded at the judge's discretion.

Antique/heirloom quilts and quilts not to be judged may be entered in the category "display only." Any information known about a family heirloom or antique quilt should accompany the item.

Reasonable care will be taken to protect items submitted from accidents, loss, damage, or theft during the course of the event. The Redbud Quilt Guild and its members are not in any way to be held responsible for accidents, loss, or damage by water, fire, theft, or otherwise whatever may be the cause or extent of the damage or loss. Information: Quilt Sizes, Categories, and Techniques

Bed Quilts: intended for use on a bed or sofa

large have a perimeter total of 300 inches or more

small have a perimeter total of 299 inches or less

Wall Quilts: intended for display on a wall;

must indicate means of hanging

Miniature Quilts: no larger than 24 x 24 inches

Baby Quilts: must be of a theme and size appropriate for a baby/child

Original Quilts: designed and constructed by the entrant to reflect innovative construction/design techniques, themes, subject matter, and/or material; commercial pattern designs are not eligible in this category

Wearables: designed as apparel or apparel accessories

Home Accessories: table runners/covers, placemats, pot holders, etc.

Group Entry: three or more persons involved in construction and/or quilting

First Time Entry: first time entrant has submitted to a Redbud Show

Junior Entry: maker is less than 18 years of age

Pieced: piecing predominates as the technique used in amount or effect

Applique: applique predominates over other techniques in amount

Special: a quilt where two or more traditional and/or non-traditional construction techniques are used to develop the design of the top; to include, but not limited to, embroidery, whole cloth, cross stitch, cheater cloth, photo transfer, etc.
